The elevation of Bhutan is not so high compared to the high elevation of Nepal. Therefore, any bike with good condition and proper mileage performance is affordable for the Bhutan Moto bike tour.

Trip Itinerary

- Day 1 - Arrival in Kathmandu and transfer to hotel (1400 Mtr/4592 Ft)
- Day2 - Deal and explore the Kathmandu city.
- Day 3 - Catch a flight to Paro (2,300 m) and ride to Thimphu (2,600 m) in a motorbike.
- Day 4 - Motorbiking to Punakha from Thimphu and hiking to Wangduehodrang.
- Day 5 - Motorbike ride from Punakha (1,600 m) to Gangtey.
- Day 6 - Motorbike riding to Paro from Gangtey.
- Day 7 - Excursion in Paro, Hiking to Tiger Nest (Taktshang Monastery).
- Day 8 - Departure from Bhutan, Paro Airport to Kathmandu.
- Day 9 - Departure to native destination.
