

Kanchanjunga Region Trek



Trip Overview

Kanchenjunga is the third highest summit of the world situated in the northeastern part of Nepal. It is considered to be one of the most beautiful mountain massifs in the world. It is a special and unforgettable destination among the trekkers because of its landscape, and amazing topography of the land. We can see massive wildlife during the trekking such as snow leopards, Musk deer, Red pandas, and many more. Kanchenjunga Circuit Trek is a chance to reach the basecamp of Kanchenjunga mountain, a really pleasing trail that offers us wonderful mountains, as well as traditional local culture, customs, a tradition of local inhabitants, magnificent views of the frozen lake crystal and glacier excursion, are the best point of views of the Kanchenjunga trekking route.

- Day 6 - Trek to Yamphudin (2080Mtr/6822 Ft)
- Day 7 - Trek to Tortong (2,995Mtr/9824 Ft)
- Day 8 - Trek to Cheram (3,870Mtr/12693 Ft)
- Day 9 - Cheram: Acclimatization and Rest
- Day 10 - Trek Ramchaur (Ramche) (4,580Mtr/15022 Ft)
- Day 11 - Trek to Yalung Base Camp (4500Mtr/14760 Ft), back to Cheram
- Day 12 - Trek to Sele La (4290Mtr/14071 Ft)
- Day 13 - Trek to Ghunsa (3,595Mtr/11792 Ft)
- Day 14 - Trek to Kambachen (4,050Mtr/13284 Ft)
- Day 15 - Trek to Lhonak (4,780Mtr/15678 Ft)
- Day 16 - Trek Kanchenjunga base camp, overnight at Pangpema (5,143Mtr/16869 Ft)
- Day 17 - Trek to Lhonak (4,780Mtr/15678 Ft)
- Day 18 - Trek to Ghunsa (3475Mtr/11398 Ft)
- Day 19 - Trek to Amjilosa (2,308Mtr/7570 Ft)
- Day 20 - Trek to Chirwa (1,270Mtr/4165 Ft)
- Day 21 - Trek to Phurumbu (1,549Mtr/5080 Mtr)
- Day 22 - Trek to Suketar
- Day 23 - Fly back to Kathmandu
- Day 24 - Final departure for home
